Special Notes regarding State

- Our league has grown tremendously in recent years. It's too large and impossible to have our state championships in 1 day. That's no longer an option.
- In each of the last two seasons we successfully utilized a multi-day format that was well received. We will continue to use that format to ensure the State Championships are comfortable for players, coaches, and parents.
- State competition will be played over 10 days, Feb 16-25 (it's not super complex, please read through the attached calendar to see the exact days)
- All awards (player medals and team trophies) will be presented at the end of competition.
- Players must arrive 30 min early for their scheduled match where possible (we recognize that 3:30 after school matches will be a challenge)
- Winning players must stay to referee.
- We will need help refereeing the first matches of each day. (Volunteers or self-ref)
- All Elementary, Middle School, & JV3 matches are 2 out of 3 to 11, tiebreaker to 11.
- All Varsity, JV1, & JV2 matches are 2 out of 3 to 15, tiebreaker to 11
