

RACQUETBALL ETIQUETTE CHECKLIST

REMINDER FOR PARENTS, STUDENTS, & COACHES

- □ No shouting or coaching while the ball is in play. Until the referee makes a call, no noise should be made.
- □ If parents & coaches disagree with a referees call, they need to bring it to the attention of the referee's coach or the tournament director (if available). The parent & coach with the issue should not take the situation upon themselves to confront the referee. Judgment calls aren't going to be overturned... Specific rule interpretations could be.
- Profanity is unacceptable
- Players must wear their eye guards the entire time they are on the court.
- □ The use of two-way radios, walkie-talkies, speaker-type phones, etc. is not allowed as coaching aids.
- □ The players are allowed only 30 seconds for timeouts. Players and coaches need to adhere to this guideline.
- No running in the hallways of clubs.
- □ In-between rallies the players can only be coached at the JV2, JV3, & Middle School levels. All levels can be coached during time-outs.
- □ When celebrating after a great rally, there will be no slapping the court walls or banging on the glass.
