

## RACQUETBALL ETIQUETTE CHECKLIST REMINDER FOR PARENTS, STUDENTS, & COACHES

<b>No shouting or coaching while the ball is in play.</b> Until the referee makes a call, no
noise should be made.
If parents & coaches disagree with a referee's call, they need to bring it to the attention of the
referee's coach or the tournament director (if available). The parent & coach with the
issue should not take the situation upon themselves to confront the referee.
Judgment calls aren't going to be overturned Specific rule interpretations could be.
Profanity is unacceptable
Players must wear their eye guards the entire time they are on the court.
The use of two-way radios, walkie-talkies, speaker-type phones, etc. is not allowed as
coaching aids.
The players are allowed only 60 seconds for timeouts. Players and coaches need to
adhere to this guideline.
No running in the hallways of clubs.
In-between rallies the players can only be coached at the JV2, JV3, & Middle School levels. All
levels can be coached during time-outs.
When celebrating after a great rally, there will be <b>no slapping the court walls or banging</b>
on the glass.
